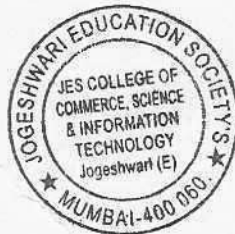

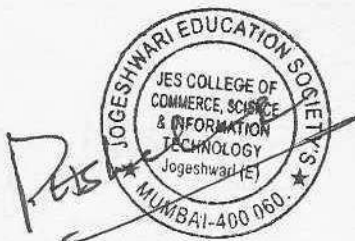

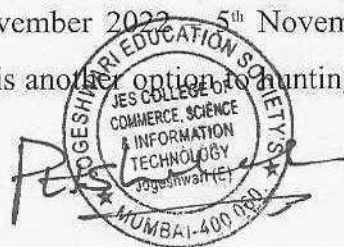


## E. Proceedings & Remarks

Prof. (Dr.) Sunita Sharma welcomed all the members of IQAC for the second meeting of IQAC for the Academic Year 2022 – 2023. She read out the minutes of the meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> August 2022, which was approved by all the members. This was followed by presentation of reports of various activities organised by IQAC from August – November 2022.

Dr. Sunita Sharma listed the program conducted by IQAC

- Four Bridge Courses conducted from 1<sup>st</sup> August – 8<sup>th</sup> August 2022
  - B.Com – Fundamentals of Mathematics
  - B.M.S. – Communication Skills and Preparation of PPT
  - B.A.F – Basic Accountancy
  - B.Sc. I.T. – Foundation of computers
- With the objective to sensitize the students about gender discrimination in the society, and different issues relating to LGBTQIA+ community a Gender Week sensitization programme was organized by IQAC in collaboration with WDC and ICC, titled “SAMANATA”. It was organized from 20<sup>th</sup> Sept – 26<sup>th</sup> Sept, 2022 and different topics covered were – Toxic Transformative – Unpacking Masculinity, Women’s Movement contribution towards advancing women rights, Breaking the binaries: Gender as a spectrum, Workshop on and Kill rape culture not the rapist.
- A student Induction Program by AICTE on Universal Human Values was conducted from 26<sup>th</sup> Sept – 1<sup>st</sup> October 2022. This 6 days online workshop is specially designed for sharing AICTE’s approach for inculcating human values and cultural enrichment. This was attended by 67 students.
- To explain the teacher’s different student centric teaching methods a webinar on “Enhancing Teaching Learning Experiences in HEIs” was organized on September 20, 2022. The speaker for the webinar was Dr. Deepak Nanaware, Trustee and Resource Person of IQAC Cluster. This was followed by conducting a meeting of teachers in which they were made to write what different student centric teaching methods they would be using in the classroom.
- IQAC & Student’s Council in Association with MBTLA Academy organized 40 hours Skill Development Course on “Udyojakta Demystified: Anyone Can” – Entrepreneurship Development Training, 1<sup>st</sup> November 2022 – 5<sup>th</sup> November 2022. The objective was to let student know that there is another option for hunting for work



– self-employment. This was followed by Business Plan Competition. All the 27 students who attended the Workshop presented their Business Plans with their teams. On 5<sup>th</sup> November 2022 the participants also conducted a Marketing Research Survey on the product they had selected for their business plans.

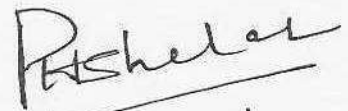
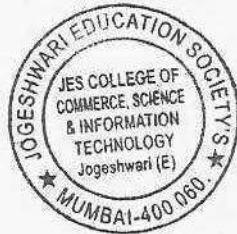

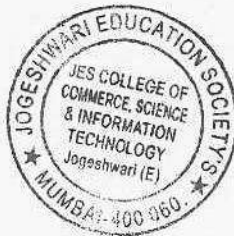
