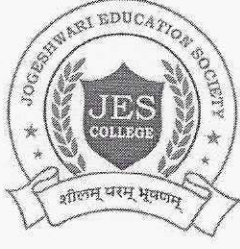

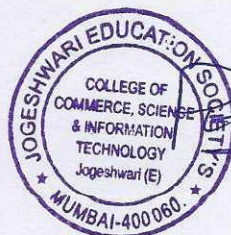

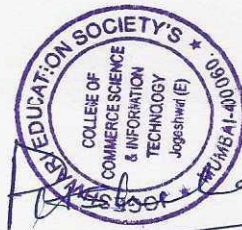

- A research gap exists when there is a new idea that hasn't been studied before or when an existing research problem and adopting a clear methodology will lead to breakthrough results.

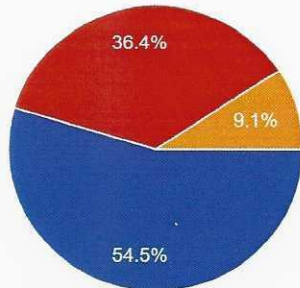

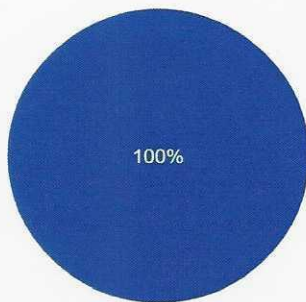
