



She read out the minutes of the meeting held on 13th August 2022, which was approved by all the members. This was followed by presentation of reports of various activities organised by IQAC from August – November 2022.

Dr. Sunita Sharma listed the program conducted by IQAC

- Four Bridge Courses conducted from 1st August 8th August 2022
 - BCom Fundamentals of Mathematics
 - o B.M.S. Communication Skills and Preparation of PPT
 - O B.A.F Basic Accountancy
 - o B.Sc. I.T. Foundation of computers
- With the objective to sensitize the students about gender discrimination in the society, and different issues relating to LGBTQIA+ community a Gender Week sensitization programme was organized by IQAC in collaboration with WDC and ICC, titled "SAMANATA". It was organized from 20th Sept 26th Sept, 2022 and different topics covered were Toxic Transformative Unpacking Masculinity, Women's Movement contribution towards advancing women rights, Breaking the binaries: Gender as a spectrum, Workshop on and Kill rape culture not the rapist.



Different questions of teachers were answered like difference between MOUs & Linkages, registration of students for ABC, Internships, field projects etc.


- College Alumni Association formed and first Get together organized on 21/01/2023.
