Prof. (Dr). Sunita Sharma presented a summary of what was planned and what activities were conducted throughout the year as presented in the table below.



- a) Mr Kiran Kamat questioned the senior college that when our school students participate in sports at national level, why not the students of the college?
- b) Mr. Manoj Phene, Chairperson and Mr. Kiran Kamat Secretary JES Management gave the following suggestions to be implemented in the upcoming year so as to strengthen sports participation in the institution.
- Take help of the coaches hired by the school to train students of senior college.
- Encourage students to take part in sports by giving cash prizes.
- Give appreciation certificates to students from the institution when they win prizes by participating in other colleges/university/state/national & international level.
