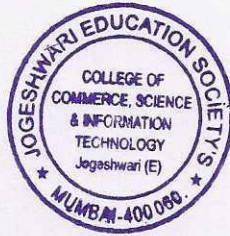
Summary of Activities:


- **Voters Awareness Program:** regular activity which is planned every year by ELC Committee.
