
Graphical Presentation of SYBCOM Students Feedback on Curriculum

Graphical Presentation of TYBCOM Students Feedback on Curriculum



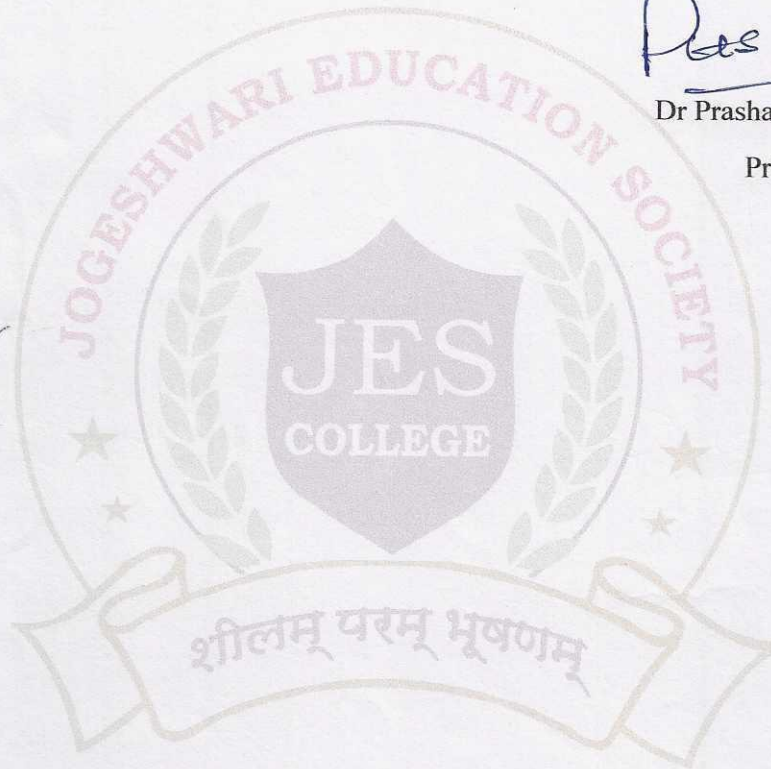
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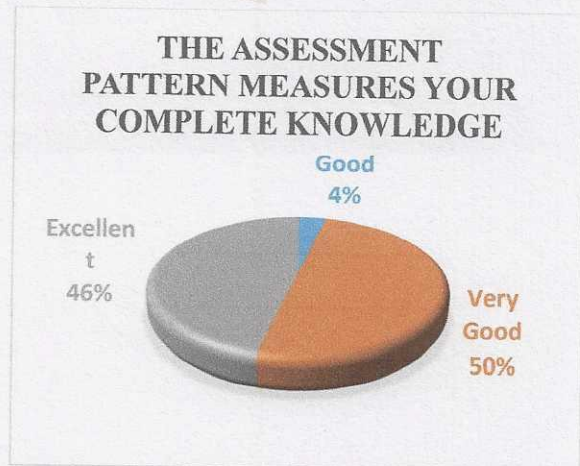
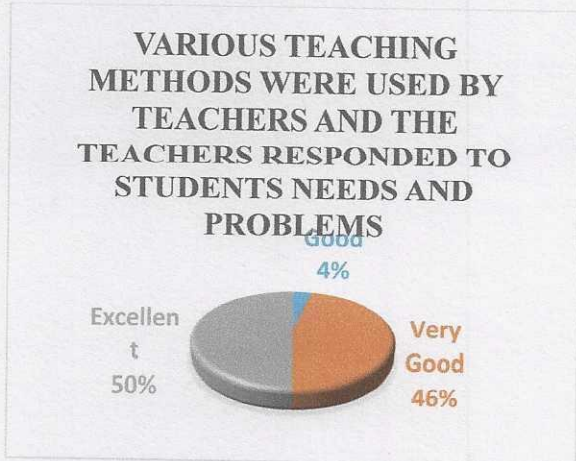
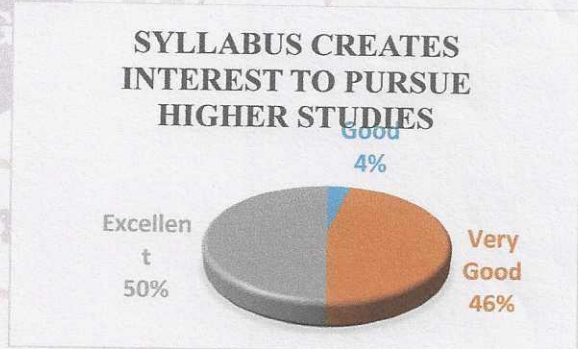
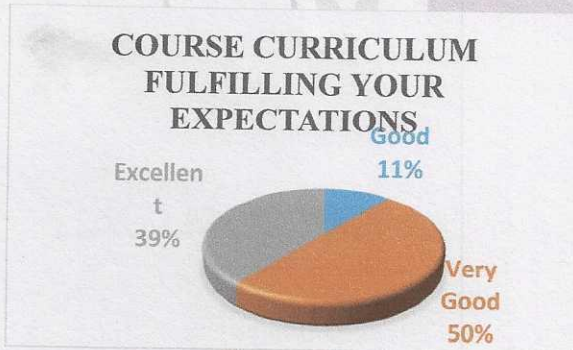
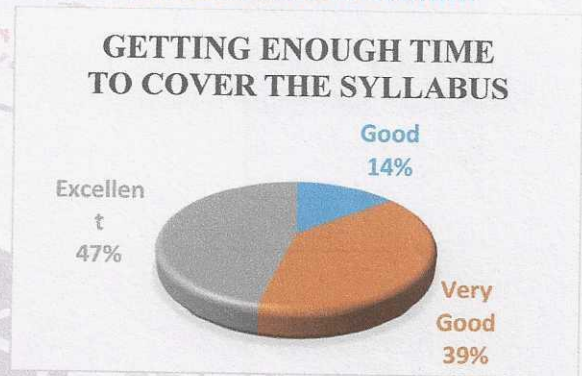
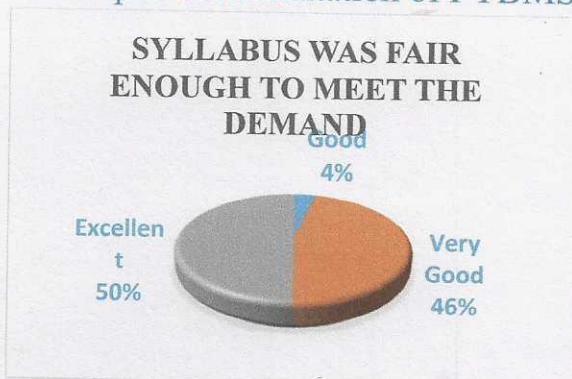
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




The feedback form was filled by 67 percent students. The analysis revealed the following:



Graphical Presentation of SYBMS Students Feedback on Curriculum



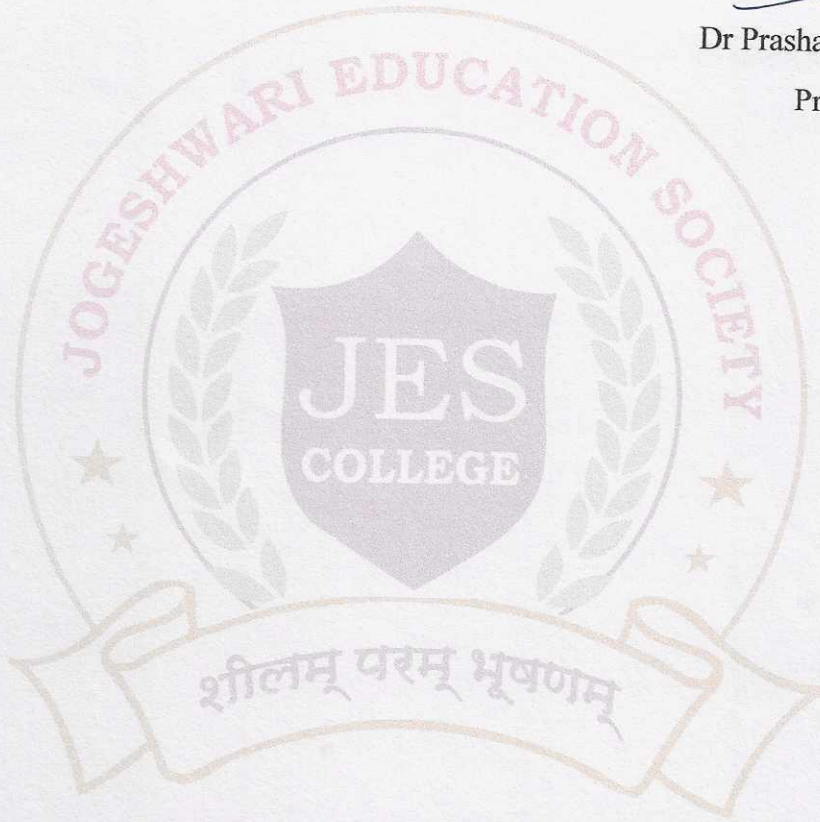
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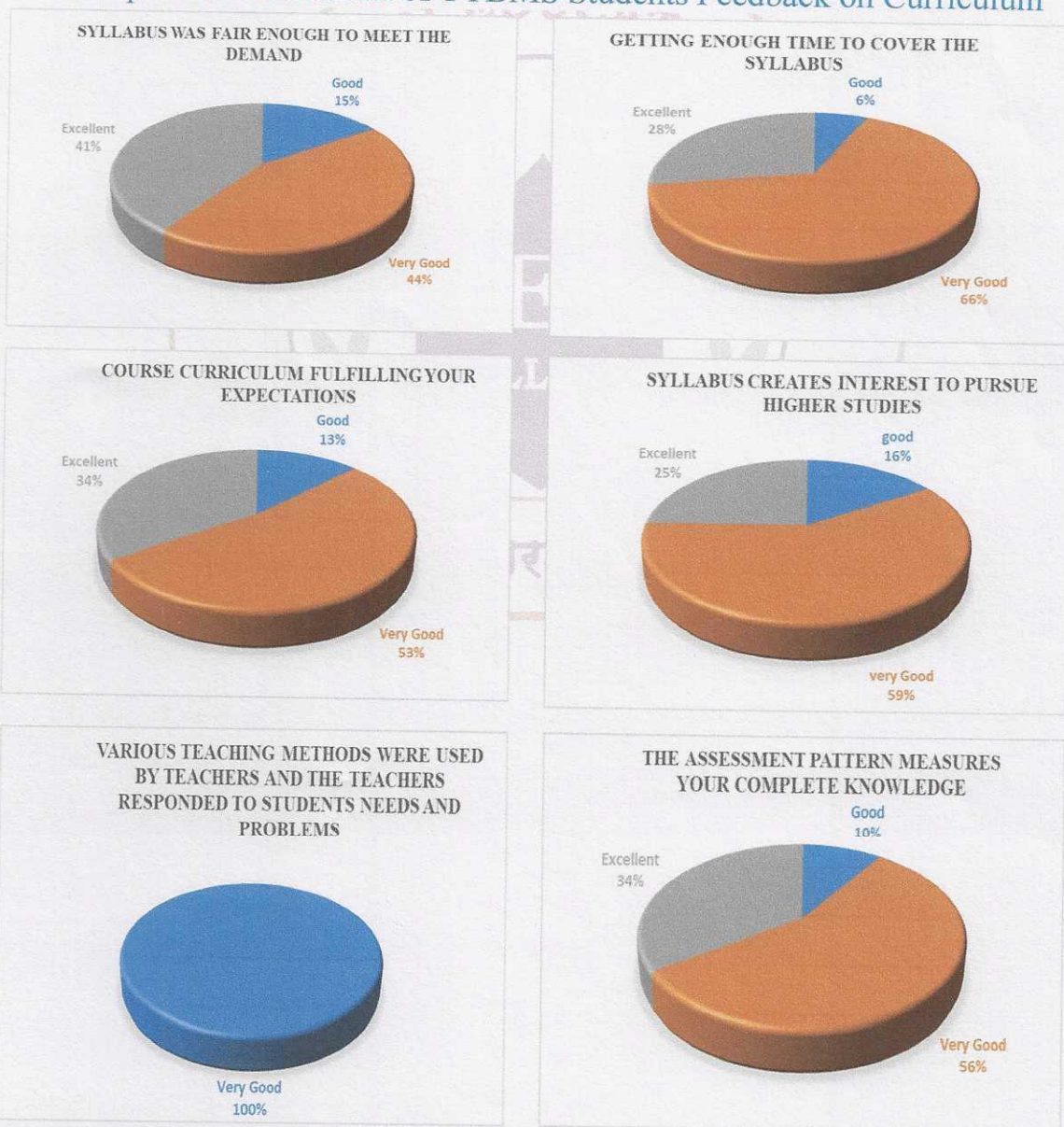



Graphical Presentation of TYBMS Students Feedback on Curriculum



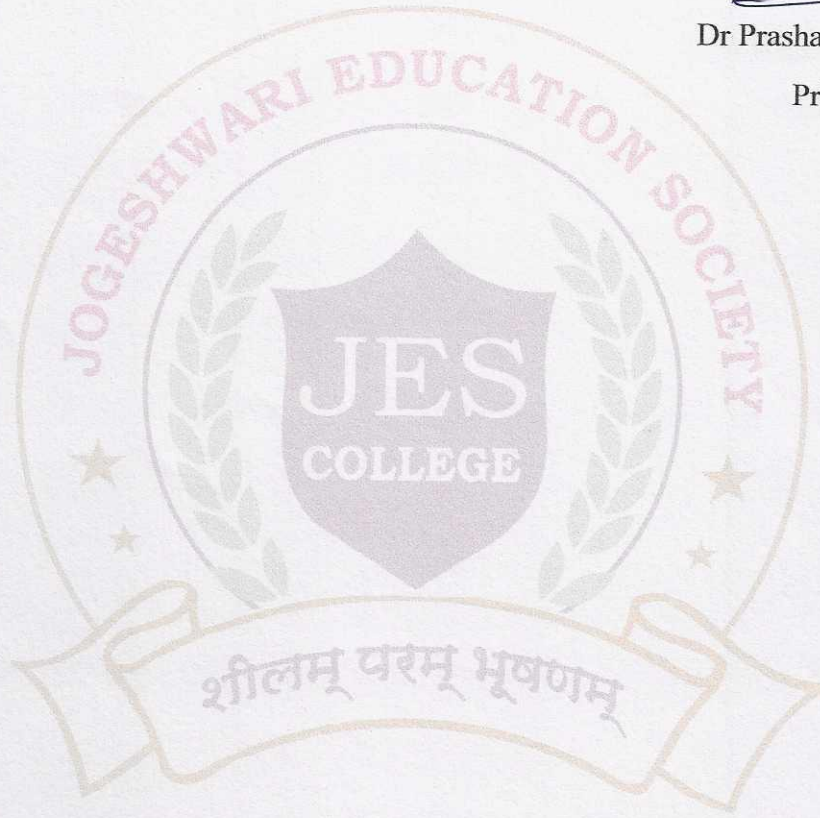
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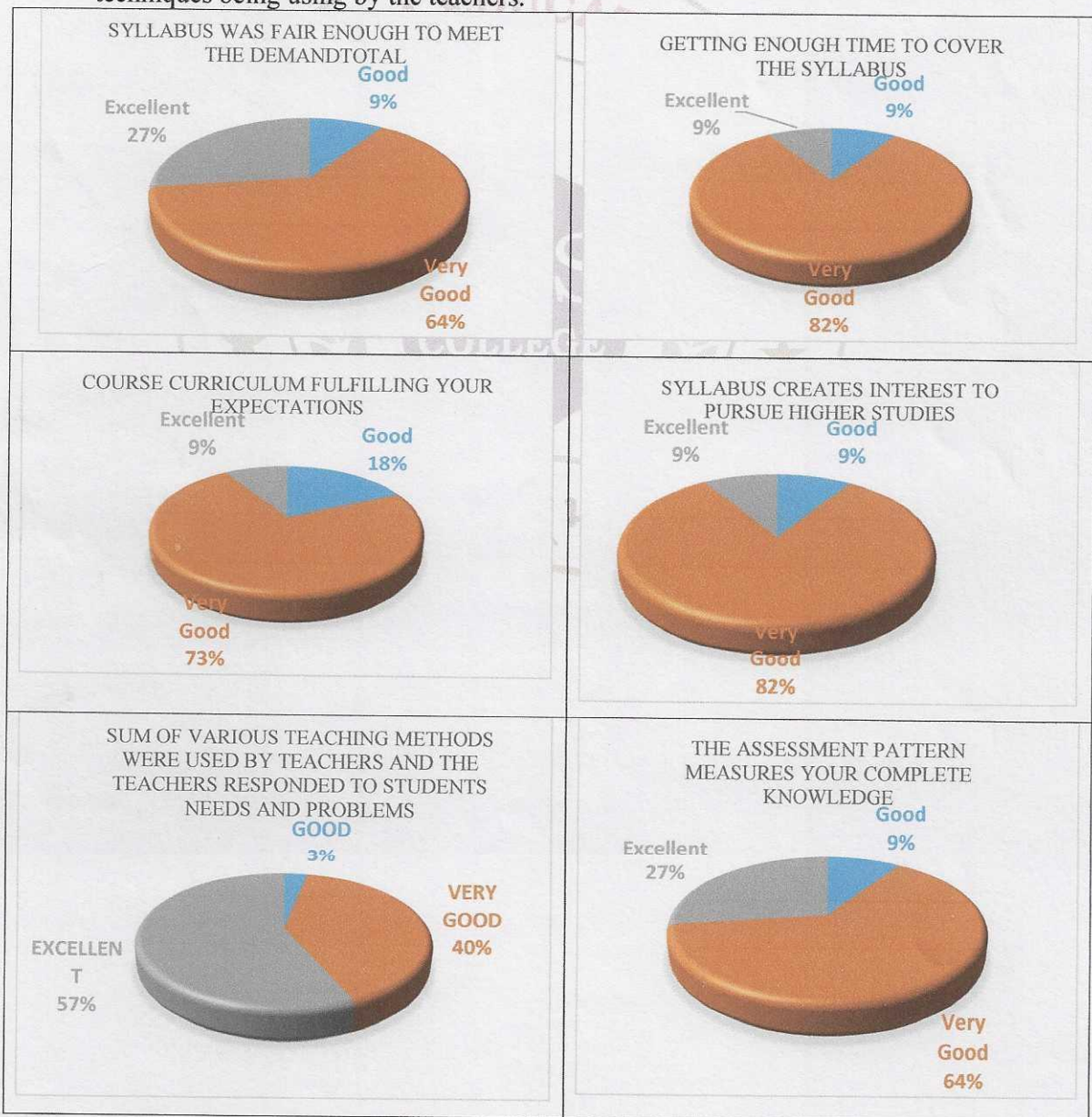

REPORT OF F.Y.BAF STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

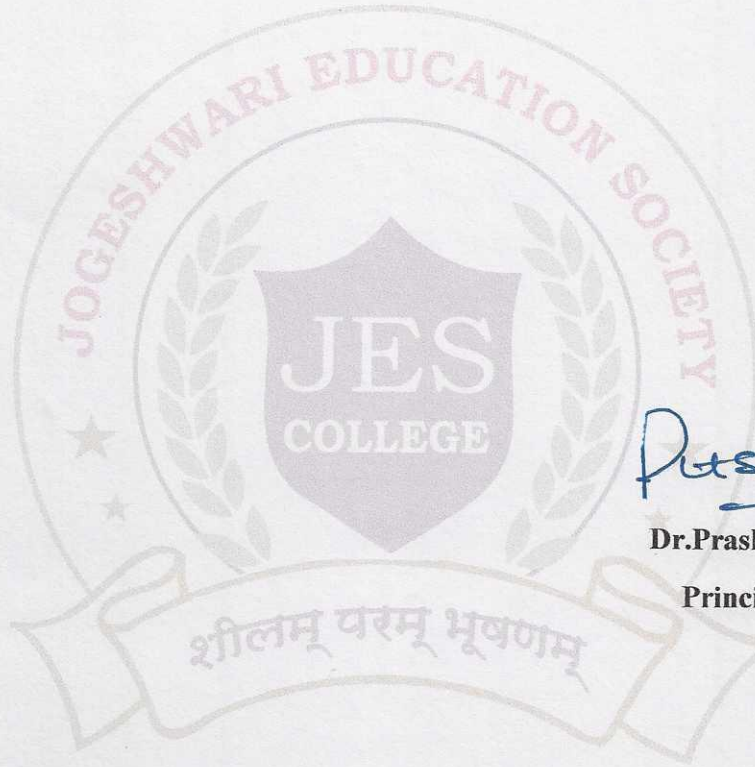

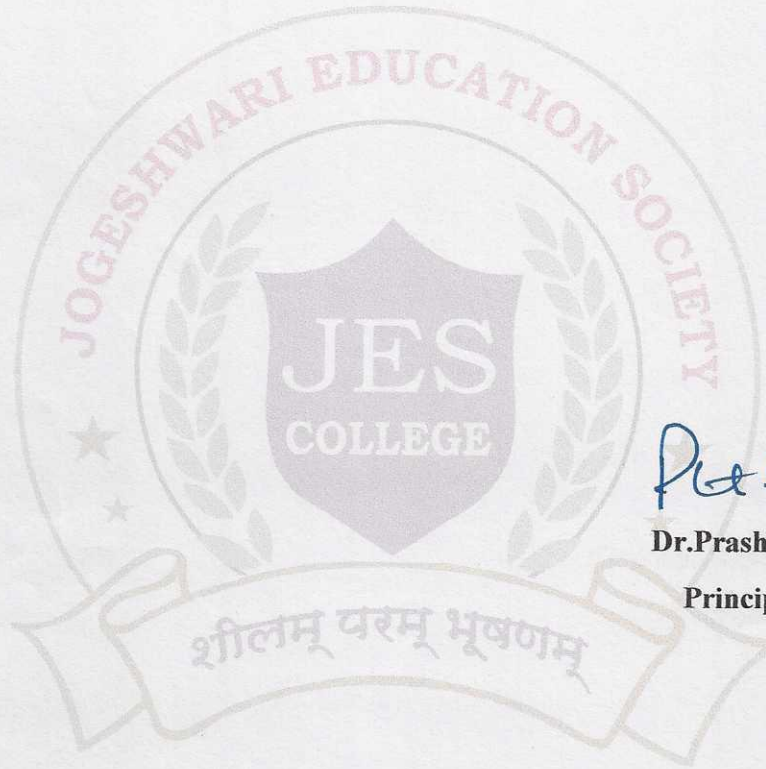
The curriculum feedback form was filled by 67 percent students. The analysis revealed the following.
