Our JES College collaborated with Akshara Centre which is dedicated towards providing financial resources to girls who are socio – economically marginalized. 37 girls were helped to get scholarships from Akshara Centre in the academic year 2024 – 2025. The amount varied from Rs. 3500 – Rs.7500.

TWO BEST PRACTICES FOR THE YEAR 2024 -2025 BEST PRACTICE I

The Hands of Hope Foundation's (THOHF) mission is to help children recognise, prevent, and be protected from any form of sexual violence through proper education & awareness, and to build a safe, happy, environment for the present and future generations of our society. THOHF is one of the first NGOs to exclusively use the creative medium in addressing child sexual abuse through its innovative creative campaigns. Apart from raising awareness, conducting creative workshops on child sexual abuse, and developing creative resources to train children and adults. 20 students were trained by Ms. Insia, so as to create awareness on child sexual abuse with school children aged 6-16 years.

All the 20 students trained conducted the sessions on Personal Safety. Total 123 conductions were conducted. The conductions were conducted in Schools, Communities, Tuition classes, Associations and Orphanages. School children aged 6-16 years were covered and total beneficiaries covered were 2219.

8 students of JES College taught computers to learners (Std V to IX) of Guru Nanak English School for two months. They were felicitated by RCMSEP on 26th January 2025.


