



Descriptive Report of Regular and Camp Activities for the Academic Year 2025 -2026

Mangroves Cleaning and Beach Cleaning

The NSS unit embarked on mangrove cleaning drive on 08-06-2025, 14-06-2025, 13-07-2025, 27-07-2025 and 20-09-2025 removing around 350 kilograms of trash from the Mangroves. Among the debris almost 126 plastic bottles and 80 glass bottles were collected highlighting the urgent need for conservation efforts in preserving these vital habitats. Volunteers also helped in cleaning Versova Beach after Ganpati Bappa Visarjan on 09-09-2025. Our volunteers also visited Juhu Koliwada for cleaning the coast on 29-10-2025.

Paper Bag Making and Distribution

The NSS unit successfully organized a paper bag making on 03-06-2025, 04-06-2025, 21-07-2025, 22-07-2025 and distribution event on 05-06-2025 and 24-07-2025, producing and distributing around 2,536 paper bags. Volunteers from the NSS unit were actively involved in the creation and distribution process, ensuring that the bags reached various community members and local businesses. This initiative aimed to promote eco-friendly environment and reduce plastic usage in the community.

Seed Ball Making

The NSS unit along with other students of the college collected different variety of seeds on 05-06-2025 among which majority of them were of fruits. After the seed balls were made the same were taken to the adopted village and were planted there at different places in the village so that the villagers can ripe the fruit in near future.

Mission on Operation Sindoor

The NSS unit organized an event on Mission on Operation Sindoor in the college where a film was shown to students which embarked how terrorism attacks are made and how our Indian Soldiers under goes mission without caring for their own lives to keep us safe. They attack the terrorist and saves lives of millions of people.

International Yoga Day

International Yoga Day was celebrated at Versova Beach on 21-06-2025 and it was also celebrated in college with the main aim of showing the importance on Yoga in today's hectic and stressful life.

No Drug Rally

The NSS volunteers participated in this rally on 19-07-2025 organised by University to show the ill effects of drugs and to inform the society about the consequences caused due to drugs. Now a days young children are becoming victims of the same, so the rally helped to send the message about the same in the society.

Tree Plantation at Aarey Colony and Kandivali

The NSS unit organized a tree plantation drive at Aarey Colony on 20-07-2025 and at Kandivali on 15-11-2025, resulting in the planting around more than 135 saplings. This event aimed to enhance the green cover and promote environmental sustainability. Volunteers from the NSS unit, along with organizers, actively participated in the plantation process, ensuring a diverse variety of native species were planted to support local biodiversity.

Kargil Vijay Diwas

Kargil Vijay Diwas was celebrated in college on 26-07-2025 for NSS volunteers to show them how our jawans survive there to protect our country due to which we can safely move in our country.

Blood Donation Camp

Blood Donation camp was organized in our college premises on 29-07-2025 and 23-11-2025 where around 142 bottles of blood were collected including both the camps. NIRADHAR foundation had organized this camp in our college as one of our Management member is active member with this foundation.

Rakhi Making Competition

The NSS volunteers had organized Rakhi making competition on 02-08-2025. Many students actively participated in it but the major attraction was those who could not participate donated rakhi's especially for the children you cannot enjoy this festival. This activity gave a quick turn to our thoughts and we decided to tie

rakhis to the children in our adopted village. Few volunteers went there and tied rakhi and duly enjoyed with the school children there.

Patriotic Song Competition

On 13-08-2025 the NSS Unit had organized class wise patriotic song competition in the college auditorium. It was great way to begin our celebration of Independence Day.

Independence Day Celebration

We celebrate Independence Day with great enthusiasm and NSS unit always helps in managing the crowd. We have Management Trustee Members, principals of our school section, Junior and Degree College Principal, teachers and all our dear students who come together to hoist our National Flag which is followed by small function.

First Aid Workshop

This workshop was specially arranged for NSS volunteers on 15-09-2025 to make them understand the importance of CPR and demo of the same was shown to the volunteers. Many volunteers themselves tried CPR on the dummy provided to them.

Street Play Workshop

Special Street Play workshop was organised on 16-09-2025 to help the volunteers understand the importance of street play and how to perform the same at different places. This workshop helped them a lot and almost 5 different street plays were organised based on the training received. Lot of volunteers had stage fear to perform the street play but after attending this workshop they got confident to perform play in front of the crowd.

Health Check Up

On 24-0-2025, health check-up camp was organised in college premises where almost 105 beneficiaries were benefited and necessary medical advice was given to them. Some of them were suggested to visit the hospitals for further check-up. In this health check-up camp people from different communities visited and they even had benefit of eye check-up as it was part of health check-up.

Red Ribbon Club

On 26-09-2025, Red Ribbon Club (RRC) inauguration was done by the hands of our Principal Sir, Dr Prashant H Shelar, on the same day a short film was shown to the volunteers to spread the awareness about AIDS. On 12-11-2025 Poster making competition was organized by the club and the topic was spreading awareness about AIDS. On 20-11-2025 Essay writing competition was organized in the college among the students of different classes and streams. Pamphlets were distributed to spread awareness about HIV Aids on 03-12-2025. Slogan writing competition was organized on 04-12-2025.

Session on ICT Tools and CANVA

The NSS unit organized two different sessions on 27-09-2025 and 29-09-2025 of two hours for the volunteers. This session was conducted by one of our Alumni who was also an NSS volunteer. He taught volunteers how to make use of ICT Tools and also how to use CANVA for different purpose.

Maritime Week

Maritime week was an event organized on 27-10-2025 for helping the marine department by University of Mumbai. Our volunteers were very happy to attend the event and they could see different sculptors made of sand. It was one of the great experience to see such wonderful things made out of sand.

Cleaning Drive

The JES College NSS unit organized a successful cleanliness drive in college campus on 25-09-2025, and 06-03-2026 awareness campaign at the bus station and college campus. Volunteers actively engaged in maintaining cleanliness, spreading awareness about environmental conservation, and promoting hygiene practices among commuters and students alike. The initiative received positive feedback from participants and stakeholders, highlighting the unit's commitment to community service and social responsibility.

Street Play

The NSS unit showed different street plays on different topics like "Street play on social issues" on 24-09-2025 at Meghwadi, other team showed the same topic in college campus also. Street play was also focused on 150th Anniversary of Sardar Vallabhai Patel. A street play about HIV Aids topic was shown to the beneficiaries on 01-12-2025. On 08-01-2026 Electro Literacy awareness Street Play was shown to people before elections. On 27-02-2025 street play on Marathi Diwas was shown to college students and school students making them

understand the importance of Marathi Language. The play highlighted diverse issues through dramatic performances and engaged the community in discussions to promote social consciousness and responsible behavior.

Mass singing of Vande Mataram

On 07-11-2025 Mass signing of Vande Mataram was organized by University of Mumbai. Our almost 35 volunteers attended the event at University Sports ground at Marine Lines. Many colleges had come there for mass singing of Vande Mataram. The icing on the cake was great singer Mr. Shankar Mahadevan was invited to sing the song.

Collection Drive

On 12-12-2025 our NSS volunteers took up a collection drive for about 4 hours where people from different strata came and donated clothes, bags, toys and many other useful things for those who can't afford anything. We collected quite a lot of things and later took them at our campsite for donation. People in village were very happy to receive such things.

7 Days Special Camp

Our camp started on 23-12-2025, around 60 students were there on the first day for the camp. All of them boarded at Andheri and got down at Palghar. Our campsite is at Kokner, located at Palghar.

1st Day (23-12-2025)

We reached our campsite at around 11:00 am. Our few volunteers had already done some pre cleaning work. So began with inauguration which was done by our Principal Sir. After that volunteers started with cleaning the campus. In afternoon after lunch we had ice breaking session and 6 groups were formed.

2nd Day (24-12-2025)

In morning we had warmup session and then volunteers started their day with Shramadaan. On 2nd day DSO of Palghar district, Mr Suhas Whanmane visited campsite with one of the famous Kabbadi player Mr. Girish Ernak who played for UMumba team. We also had Nasha Mukti session on second day.

3rd Day (25-12-2025)

On third day the volunteers started their day with warmup and Shramadaan. Since it was 25th December, Christmas Day we planned to visit Ashram school in

the nearby vicinity. Various recreational activities were conducted and our volunteers played with the children at Ashram School.

4th Day (26-12-2025)

After Shramadaan our volunteers went for survey in village. Few volunteers went for painting the temple. In afternoon we had session on water shed management. At night one of our faculty members had got telescope for sky gazing. He gave nice information about the stars and planets. We could see the beauty of the moon through telescope.

5th Day (27-12-2025)

Alumni had specially come to visit the campsite and to meet the volunteers. All the volunteers had interactive session with them. Along with Alumni volunteers went to visit the Ashram school and they distributed snacks to the students there. Street play on "Comfortable and uncomfortable touch" was performed in front of the students.

6th Day (28-12-2025)

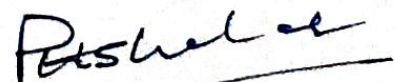
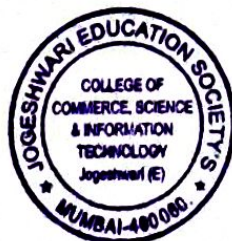
