5. Farewell Day (28 March 2026)

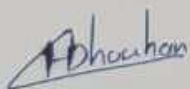

6. Convocation Ceremony (11 April 2026)

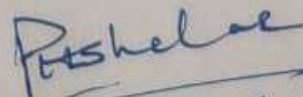
