OUR FOUNDER | THE VISIONARY

Shri Shantaram Ganaba Warty (1887–1939)

A visionary educationist and social reformer, Shri Shantaram Ganaba Warty laid the foundation of the Society's educational journey by starting two classes at a small residence in Saraswati Baug in 1932. His foresight, commitment to education and concern for social progress laid the foundation for the development of a growing chain of educational institutions.

HIS LITERARY & EDUCATIONAL CONTRIBUTIONS

- **1924:** Published six articles in *The Times of India* on BMC school reforms, contributing to the elementary school reform movement.
- **1928:** Authored *Sister India*, presenting a perspective on Indian womanhood.
- **1935:** Published *What is Wrong with Bombay University*, raising concerns regarding university policies and educational reforms.
- **1938:** Served as Editor of *Indian World Magazine*, Baroda.
